






Little duckling taps hard from inside her egg to break the shell, and hatches out into the big wide world. But where is her mom? **She decides to go and look.**

The little duckling wanders out into the yard.


“**Hello!**” cheeps a fluffy yellow chick “**I’m Chicky**. What’s your name?”

“Why is that chicken on the fence making such a **horrible noise?**” asks Hope.


“He is a rooster and is our dad. He looks after us and crows in the morning **to wake us all up**” chirps Chicky.







“Hello” says Curly the lamb bouncing over.
